## **Penguin to publish Evelyn Waugh eBooks**

The Evelyn Waugh catalogue to be made available in electronic formats under the ePenguin imprint.

Penguin will be publishing the classic fiction and non-fiction of one of Britain's best-loved writers in ebook formats, starting with electronic publication of *Decline and Fall*, *Sword of Honour* and *The Ordeal of Gilbert Pinfold* in September 2002. These will be initially published in the popular Microsoft Reader and Adobe Acrobat eBook Reader formats with further formats to be announced in the very near future. Further titles, including *Scoop*, *Brideshead Revisited* and *Officers and Gentlemen* will follow the initial release, with new electronic Evelyn Waugh titles appearing on a monthly basis, all priced at £6.39.

Simon Winder, Editorial Director of the Penguin Press said: "It is fantastic to have one of the greatest British novelists available electronically. Penguin has published Waugh for many decades and it is brilliantly appropriate that as we approach the centenary of his birth these magical books should find a fresh life in this totally new format."
